


# WE WILL RISE










### **2020 NEEDLEPOINT MOSAICS**

I used their Gimp for spider legs and Eyelash for the moss on the roof. Great threads with some fun potential. I love the journey I take with each project. The stitching is only part of the adventure; sometimes writing the guides can be just as challenging.
